Functions: talking about habits and routines, talking about free-time activities, expressing likes and dislikes, making arrangements, talking about clothes, going shopping, talking about eating habits, ordering food.

Modal verbs of obligation and necessity: Have to/must (anche al negativo)

Needn't/don't need to

Unit 4-6: Family, celebrations, sports, films and tv series.

Past simple del verbo to be/to have in affirmative, negative and questions

Past simple di verbi regolari e irregolari

Subject and object questions,

Adverbs of manners

Past continuous vs Past simple.

Past simple modal verbs: could, had to.

Functions: asking about the weekend, talking about abilities and possibilities in the present and in the past, expressing opinions.

Unit 7-9: Comparisons of majority and minority, superlatives.

Present perfect simple with just, already, yet. Past simple vs. present perfect.

Comparative and superlative adjectives

Be going to: future intentions, predictions based on present evidence. Will.

Vocabulary: Personality, feelings and emotions, household chores, parts of the house and furnishings. Jobs.

Functions: Talking about problems, offering help, talking about hopes, plans and intentions. Job interview.

Unit 10-12: Talking about the future

Present continuous as future. Present simple as future, Both, either...or/ neither...nor.

Must, have to, mustn't, don't have to, don't need to.

Vocabulary: Holidays, Travelling, luggage. The natural world. The weather. School teaching and learning.

Language functions: talking about future holidays, making travel arrangements, talking about the weather, talking about obligation, agreeing and disagreeing.
